Review of Members and Outside Bodies

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To update the members of the committee on the results of the review of members and outside bodies .

BACKGROUND

- 2. An initial review was undertaken in 2008/2009 of the representation of members on outside bodies using the Members register. The responses received as part of the review were assessed using a similar matrix to the one used to evaluate the Council's strategic partnerships. The criteria used to review the external bodies was:
 - 1. Statutory -Is the Council required by law to be represented?
 - 2. <u>Written Agreement</u> Does the external bodies constitution require Council representation AND was the Council party to the agreement on the Constitution?
 - 3. <u>Relationship to the Corporate Priorities</u> Is the bodies success critical to the achievement of Corporate Priorities?
 - 4. Support Does the Council directly contribute money/resources?
 - 5. <u>Statutory or Regulatory Context</u> Are decisions taken that are binding on the Council?
 - 6. Risk Are there consequences for the Council of failures by the body?
 - 7. Risk Does the body contribute to the management of the Council's risks?
 - 8. <u>Statutory or Regulatory Context</u> Does the representative have voting rights?

- 3. A schedule of findings from the review was presented to the committee on the 27th May 2009 as part of the report on the Corporate Governance Statement. The schedule was also presented to the Corporate Affairs Committee on the 3rd June 2009. Members considered the findings of the initial review and recommended that:
 - Officers continue the review using the outside bodies matrix during 2009/2010 and the results reported to the Corporate Affairs Committee for a decision.
 - An evaluation of whether there were any barriers to the effectiveness of partnerships and outside bodies would be included in future reviews.
- 4. The review has now been completed and the results analysed by officers from Strategic Resources and Democratic Services using the approved criteria including any barriers to effectiveness. A full schedule of findings from the review is shown in Appendix A.
- 5. The findings from the initial review to continue, withdraw or the outside body had ceased existence were all confirmed at the final review stage. The outside bodies labled as "review" in the initial review now have recommendations on whether to continue, withdraw, or to seek members views:
