Overview - Exclusion is very rare in primary and those pupils will often be placed in an alternative setting to meet their needs.

Fixed Term exclusion is used more frequently in Secondary Schools however there is significant variation between schools

Most secondary schools have over recent years developed 'in house' small group education settings to support their most challenging pupils.

The Outwood Academy Chain have just opened their own Alternative Education Provision at Normanby and it is hoped this will reduce their rates of Fixed Term and Permanent Exclusion.

Most Fixed term Exclusions will be due to threatening or disruptive behaviour and as a result of raising sanctions when warnings or detentions fail to improve behaviour or compliance with school rules.

Permanent Exclusion will normally be due to a one off serious incident or as a result of persistent disruptive, threatening or violent behaviour.

The Reasons for Permanent Exclusions in 19/20 are shown below and earlier academic years are very similar:

Drug or alcohol related - 2 pupils

Damage to school property - 2 pupils

Other reason - 3 pupils

Assault on Adult (staff) - 8 pupils

Assault on other pupil - 2 pupils

Persistent Disruptive Behaviour - 18 pupils

Violent or threatening behaviour towards an adult - 9 pupils

Violent or threatening behaviour towards another pupil - 2 pupils

Annual Rates of Permanent Exclusion by Middlesbrough Schools

18/19 - 56

19/20 - 46

Please be aware schools closed in March 1920 and Exclusion Rates would have been higher as a third of the school year was lost

\*For Middlesbrough to have Permanent Exclusion Rates in line with the National Average the numbers should be circa 18 pupils per annum.

\*Our rates are amongst the highest in England and Wales however even greater rises in exclusion rates have occurred in the other Tees Valley Authorities  
In addition a small number of pupils who live in Middlesbrough but attend schools in our neighbouring L/A's will be excluded and we are responsible for their continued education
