SCHOOL GOVERNING BODIES – APPOINTMENT OF LEA SCHOOL GOVERNORS

HEAD OF SERVICE: MRS J CORDINER, HEAD OF POLICY AND RESOURCES

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To consider and appoint LEA Governors.

BACKGROUND

- 2. Members are required to consider vacancies for LEA Appointed School Governors, which have arisen as a result of resignations, the expiry of terms of office or the removal of Governors due to non-attendance, and any vacancies deferred from previous meetings of Corporate Affairs Committee.
- 3. There are currently 16 vacancies out of a total of 142 Governorships for LEA Representatives, this equates to %.
- 4. In view of the forthcoming changes to Governing Body constitutional arrangements where the number of LEA Governors on each Governing Body is likely to reduce, it is suggested that consideration be given to ensuring there is adequate LEA representation on all Governing Bodies. Where there is only one vacancy the filling of this is not a priority, however we would not discourage any new nominees received provided they understand that the situation may change within the next year.
