(v) Parish Council Elections

- 30. The above scale of election expenses shall also apply to the election of parish councillors except that when the poll for the election of parish councillors is taken together with the poll for the election of borough councillors:-
 - (a) The fees referred to in paragraphs 14 (Presiding Officer) and 15 (Poll Clerk) shall be increased by one quarter when the number of voters allocated to the polling station is not more than 700 and by one half when the number of voters exceeds 700.
 - (b) The fees referred to in paragraphs 16 (Counting Clerks etc.) and 21
 & 22 (Returning Officer) shall be increased by one half in respect of each Parish.

(vi) Mayoral Elections

- 31. The above scale of election expenses shall also apply to the election of a mayor except that when the poll for the election of a mayor is taken together with the poll for the election of borough councillors:-
 - (a) The fees referred to in paragraphs 14 (Presiding Officer) and 15 (Poll Clerk) shall be increased by one quarter when the number of voters allocated to the polling station is not more than 700 and by one half when the number of voters exceeds 700.
 - (b) The fees referred to in paragraphs 16 (Counting Clerks etc.) and 21 & 22 (Returning Officer) shall be increased by one half.
