<b>Middlehaven</b>	No comments received.	Split polling district AC. Part west of Woodlands Road to AA. Part east of Woodlands Road to AB. Relocate polling station for AB polling district to the International Centre, Abingdon Road. (Current polling station is Meeting House, 11 Elder Court.)
<b>Ayresome</b>	Relocate polling station from Whinney Banks Primary School to St. Martin's Church Hall.	The existing polling station at Whinney Banks Primary School is geographically more central to the polling district and is a well established polling station.
<b>Gresham</b>	Additional mobile polling station to be located at the recreation ground, Outram Street.	Some years ago a mobile polling station was located at Outram Street. Due to concerns about vandalism and the safety of polling station staff, the decision was taken to relocate the polling station to Newport Neighbourhood Centre, St. Paul's Road, which is approximately 400 yards away.

<b>North Ormesby &amp; Brambles Farm</b>	No comments received.	Combine polling districts EA (1,200) and EB (1,050) to vote at North Ormesby Youth & Community Centre.
