## LICENSING COMMITTEE - INTERIM ARRANGEMENTS

### 1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 To make arrangements to appoint a Licensing Committee to cover the period between the forthcoming Election and the Council's Annual Meeting.

### 2.0 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 That a Licensing Committee be established comprising 3 members, and those members to be determined by the Director of Legal \& Democratic Services following consultation with recognised group Leaders.

### 3.0 BACKGROUND

3.1 The Council is obliged to establish a statutory Licensing Committee in addition to those committees it establishes under the Local Government Act 1972. By virtue of the Licensing legislation, it is often necessary for a meeting of a Licensing SubCommittee to be held at very short notice in order to comply with statutory timescales.
3.2 On $5^{\text {th }}$ May 2011 a full Council Election will take place and on $9^{\text {th }}$ May 2011 all current Councillors will cease to hold office unless re-elected. At its Annual Meeting on $25^{\text {th }}$ May, the Council will appoint all committees including Licensing Committee.
3.3 It has come to light that in order to comply with the statutory timescales, the Licensing Committee will need to meet on at least 2 occasions between $5^{\text {th }}$ May and $25^{\text {th }}$ May to consider relevant licensing issues. These are issues that are routinely considered by one of the Council's Licensing Sub-Committees. A Licensing Sub-Committee comprises 3 members, all of whom must have received appropriate training and none of whom can be a Ward member for the area concerned.
3.4 In order to deal with this situation, it is proposed that a Licensing Committee be established to cover the period $6^{\text {th }}$ May to $25^{\text {th }}$ May 2011. It is recommended that the membership ( 3 members) be determined by the Director of Legal \& Democratic Services following consultation with the leaders of those groups that have more than 4 members at that time.
