# Risk Management overview

- The Council has a process in place to identify and manage Risk.
- Risk is managed at the lowest level possible.
- Risks are escalated where they have wider impacts.
- Identified risks are recorded on risk registers for their management. there are risk registers for Heads of Service, Departments, projects and programmes. The overarching Risk Register is the Strategic Risk Register.

#### Committee's role in relation to Risk Management

- Assurance role, ensuring the governance around risk management is fit for purpose, rather than scrutinising how individual risks are being managed (a role for Overview and Scrutiny).
- Oversight of the Council's Risk Management Framework.

#### Committee's role in relation to Risk Management

Over the last year the Committee has received presentations on individual risks in the Strategic Risk Register. The purpose of this is to provide assurance that appropriate governance is in place. an overview of the governance in place to manage the following risks has been presented to Committee in the last year:

- Clinical Commissioning group
- General Data Protection Regulations
- Transition from elections.

### Other mechanisms in place to oversee risk

- Internal audit programme of reviews
- External Audit programme
- Overview and Scrutiny Board
- Inclusion of risks within the performance, risk and finance clinic process.
