RENAMING OF STAINTON WOOD

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To consider a request, received from Stainton and Thornton Parish Council, to rename Stainton Wood as "Maelor's Wood".

BACKGROUND

- 2. Members will recall the sudden and unexpected death of Councillor Maelor Williams shortly before last year's elections; tributes were paid to him at the Council meeting of 25 March 2015.
- 3. Subsequently, Stainton and Thornton Parish Council has approached Middlesbrough Council to seek the formal renaming of Stainton Wood in his memory. The wood is owned by Middlesbrough Council and Councillor Williams, as a governor of Tees Forest, helped plant the wood in the late 1990s.
- 4. A formal request has been submitted, and approval for the proposed change is now sought from Middlesbrough Council.
