SCRUTINY PROGRESS REPORT

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY BOARD

- 2. Since the last Council update, the Overview and Scrutiny Board met on 28 February 2017 to consider the following:

SCRUTINY PANEL UPDATES

3. The updated position in respect of the work of each of the Council's scrutiny panels is shown below.

Ad Hoc Scrutiny Panel

4. The Panel met on 13 February 2017 and received further information, from three Middlesbrough Council apprentices and a representative of Acklam Grange School, on the topic of apprenticeships. The Panel discussed the progress of the review, including the conclusions and recommendations that will be taken forward. The Panel agreed that a Draft Final Report would be produced and circulated to Members for comment, prior to the subsequent Final Report being submitted to the Overview and Scrutiny Board on 20 April 2017.

Children and Learning Scrutiny Panel

 The panel met on 8 March 2017. At the meeting, the panel received an introduction to their next topic for investigation – Pupil Exclusion in Middlesbrough. The Panel also agreed the conclusions and recommendations for inclusion in its Final Report on Family and Friends Care (Kinship Care).

Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel

5. The panel met on 6 March 2017 and received further information on the topic of sexting / youth produced sexual imagery. The Operation Manager at South Tees Youth Offending Service provided information in respect of the local picture alongside YOS recommendations to this issue.
