Middlesbrough rebranding

"We the MICA Group believe that the rebranding of Middlesbrough needs debating by this authority and the implementation of the proposed rebranding should be reconsidered.

The majority of public opinion is that the proposed rebranding is not satisfactory and unnecessary.

We have seen a number of rebrands by previous elected members, more recently Mayor Mallon, each of which have failed to achieve anything other than a significant burden on the taxpayer.
