What is the purpose of this report?

1. To consider a request from Councillor Smith for exemption from attendance at Council meetings as required by Section 85 (1) of the Local Government Act 1972

Why does this report require a Member decision?

2. Requests for exemption from attendance at Council meetings require full Council approval.

3. Councillor Smith has formally requested the authority to grant the request for an exemption with regard to attendance at Council meetings until the date of his trial.

Section 85 (I) of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that a Member will cease to be member of the authority if:

- (i) they fail to attend any meetings of the authority or any other meeting as a representative of the council;
- (ii) they have been absent for a period of six consecutive months from the date of their last attendance;
- (iii) their absence is not due to some reason approved by the authority before the expiry of that period.

Approval by the authority to grant the request with regard to attendance at Council meetings must be before the expiry of the six month period.

That Council consider the request from Councillor Smith and agree one of the following options:

- 1. To grant the request.
- 2. Not to grant the request.
