SITE 44 (LONGRIDGE), TURNBERRY WAY, COULBY NEWHAM, MIDDLESBROUGH

The Director of Regeneration and the Director of Resources submitted a report on the offers received following the marketing for sale by tender of the residential development site known as Site 44 (Longridge) at Coulby Newham. The report also recommended the selection of a 'preferred bidder' and the process of the sale.

ORDERED

- 1. Site 44 be sold to Bidder E, on the terms that they have offered as part of their mandatory (upfront payment) option**
- 2. If awarded, the scheme be tracked to see if there is any subsequent overage receipts.**

REASON
