- 4. at the Health Scrutiny Panel meeting on 21 December 2004, Members were asked for their views into support arrangements and where the arrangements could be developed to contribute to the consultation.
- 5. The views which were put forward were assimilated into a response to the consultation.

- 7. Some of the main areas of development include:
- a) the role of the NHS Appointments Commission in appoining forum members
