Specifically

- 6.1 To take evidence on the health impacts of passive smoking
- 6.2 To establish the views of the local population in relation to tobacco control in enclosed public places
- 6.3 To investigate the economic impact on Middlesbrough's businesses of tobacco control measures
- 6.4 To investigate the views of interest groups as to the impacts of tobacco control
- 6.5 To consider any lessons from elsewhere in the UK where Tobacco control has been implemented.
