Scrutiny Review – Implementation of Recommendations

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To inform the Panel of the progress achieved with the implementation of agreed Executive actions resulting from the consideration of Scrutiny reports since the last update to the Panel.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2. The electronic Scrutiny Monitoring Database was introduced in June 2003, to enable Members to track the implementation of agreed Executive Action Plans. The database is accessible through the lotus notes system.
- 3. As agreed by the OSB, the Scrutiny Panels will receive quarterly updates on the progress of Scrutiny recommendations and in particular the actions that have not been successfully implemented.
- 4. Provided within Appendix A is a position update for the following reports :-
 - Review of District General Hospital Services
 - Review of Patient & Public Involvement
 - Appropriate Hospital Care for Older People
 - Dental Health
 - Healthy Living Review
 - Tobacco Control within Enclosed Public Places
 - Out of Hours Services
- 5. Since the implementation of the monitoring system, the Health Scrutiny Panel has produced a total of 68 recommendations, of which 57 should have been implemented by October 2006. The agreed Executive actions which have not been implemented by the proposed target date are presented in Appendix A.

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- 6. To summarise, of the 57 Executive actions which should have been implemented by October 2006: -
 - 47 have been implemented,
 - 7 are partially complete,
 - 3 have not been implemented.
- 7. All of the Agreed Executive Actions for the following review have been completed:
 - (Sept 05) Emergency Admissions into James Cook University Hospital
