# JOINT STRATEGIC NEEDS ASSESSMENTS - A BRIEFING

#### PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To introduce representation from Middlesbrough's Director of Public Health, in attendance at today's meeting to provide the Panel with a briefing on the emerging concept of Joint Strategic Needs Assessments.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

2. That the Panel notes the content of the briefing delivered at today's meeting in relation to introduction of Joint Strategic Needs Assessments.

## **CONSIDERATION OF REPORT**

- 3. The Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act (2007), places a duty on (upper tier) local authorities and PCTs to undertake Joint Strategic Needs Assessments (JSNAs). JSNAs are a process that will identify the current and future health and wellbeing needs of a local population, informing the priorities and targets set by Local Area Agreements and leading to agreed commissioning priorities that will improve outcomes and reduce health inequalities<sup>1</sup>.
- 4. It is understood that the local authority and Middlesbrough PCT are currently undertaking a quantity of work to deliver a draft JSNA, which is scheduled to be consulted upon during the summer and into early autumn. It is anticipated that Health Scrutiny will be a active contributor to that consultation. Nonetheless, it was felt that a briefing for the Health Scrutiny Panel on JSNAs would be beneficial in advance of the statutory consultation period, to ensure that the consultation could be approached in an informed manner.
