PATIENT TRANSPORT SERVICES - AN UPDATE

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 3. Members of the Panel will recall that in 2007/8 municipal year, the Panel conducted a study of Patient Transport Services from James Cook University Hospital. The study focussed on people attending outpatient appointments and those requiring transport following discharge.
- 4. As part of the Review's conclusions, the Panel requested regular updates on the progress of development to Patient Transport Services. The Panel last received an update 26 February 2009. The most recent update has been received from NEAS and is appended to this brief covering report at Appendix
- 5. It is expected that a NEAS representative will take the Panel through the salient points of the update, ahead of answering any questions that the Panel has. Depending upon the discussion at today's meeting, the Panel may wish to make representations to NEAS. The Panel is asked to bear in mind that the next update is currently scheduled for March 2010.
