EMERGENCY PLANNING AND RESILIENCE IN THE NEW HEALTH STRUCTURE

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To introduce representatives from NHS Tees, in attendance to speak about how the local NHS will contribute to emergency planning and preparedness, in the new health structure.
