Attendance of Executive Member for Communities and Public Health	Councillor M Thompson, Executive Member for Communities and Public Health, attended the meeting to provide the Overview and Scrutiny Board with information on his portfolio area, responsibilities and progress made to date.
	The main responsibilities of the Executive Member's portfolio were highlighted and a number of issues discussed, including the following:
	 The need to promote and encourage strong, resilient and cohesive communities. Action and intervention to address the particular issues that affect disadvantaged communities, including health inequalities. Involvement in a number of public health projects, including drugs/alcohol and sexual health. The role of the Health and Wellbeing Board. The need to champion young people and ensure that their views are represented. The Council's role in assisting asylum seekers. OSB questioned the Executive Member and thanked him for the information provided.

Its function would be to consider a local health service review relating to the Better Health Programme. Establishment of the joint committee was agreed in principle, subject to Council approval.
