BACKGROUND AND EXTERNAL CONSULTATION

5. Appendix 1 shows the revenue expenditure to the 30th June 2012. There was an under-spend on the staffing budget due to a staff vacancy within the Archives Service. The vacancy is currently being advertised internally and the intention is to fill the post by September 2012.
6. Following completion of the service review in March 2012, the resulting ER/VR cost to the service was £6,781. The cost will be apportioned out for each Council and the final quarter payments will be adjusted to reflect the required payment, as follows:
 - Redcar and Cleveland – £1,657
 - Hartlepool - £1,103
 - Stockton - £2,321
 - Middlesbrough - £1,700
