Title	Responding to the Financial Challenges of the South Tees Health and Wellbeing System

1 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1. The purpose of this report is to present to the South Tees Single Health and Wellbeing Board a summary of the financial position of the local health and social care system and make recommendations for joint working going forward.

2 BACKGROUND

2.1 At their respective last meetings as separate health and well-being boards both the Middlesbrough Health and Wellbeing Board and the Redcar & Cleveland Health and Wellbeing Board were presented with details on NHS South Tees CCG's financial position.

It was resolved following both board meetings to map the resources available and financial pressures across the health and care system. This work is to ensure the board has a system-wide understanding of the scale of the challenges (poor outcomes, financial pressures and service delivery) and to explore opportunities for transformation and integration across the system.

- 2.3 At the Health and Well-being board meeting members from the South Tees Health and Wellbeing Executive will present a:
 - Summary of the national policy reforms and changes to the funding allocations across the health and care system,
 - An overview the local financial challenges and their impact across individual organisation and the health and care system,
 - Summary of the progress to date with establishing joint commissioning approaches for children and young people and for adults and older people,
 - Opportunity for discussion and agreeing next steps.
