SAFETY AT SPORTS GROUNDS ACT 1975-RIVERSIDE STADIUM RENEWAL OF GENERAL SAFETY CERTIFICATE – 2020/2021 FOOTBALL SEASON

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

To seek Members approval for the re-issue of the General Safety Certificate for the forthcoming football season 2020/2021.

BACKGROUND

- The Safety at Sports Grounds Act 1975 established the principle that a sports ground accommodating more than 10,000 spectators should require a Safety Certificate containing such terms and conditions as the Local Authority consider necessary or expedient to secure reasonable safety at the sports ground.
- The Safety Advisory Group (SAG) for the Riverside Stadium met on the 18th June 2020 and recommended renewal on the current terms with the exception of the capacity as stated in paragraph 4.
- 4 For matches with a non-spectator policy, Appendix A sets out the procedures the Club will follow.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- The current approved permitted number of spectators for the stadium is up to 34,000.
- Members are requested to approve the re-issue of the General Safety Certificate for the forthcoming season with a spectator capacity of 34,000.
- The Environmental Services Manager or his representative be authorised to reissue the certificate as above.
