
Cllr Storey, Cllr Uddin and myself strongly object to the license application for the above premises, to sell alcohol from 9am – 10pm daily.

This shop is located in one of the most deprived areas within Middlesbrough. There is high unemployment, low education attainments and a high prevalence of ill health, including drink and drug dependency.

As Central ward is situated in a wider Cumulative impact area, consisting of; Central ward, Newport ward, North Ormesby ward, Longlands/Beechwood ward and Park ward, we feel that if the license is granted then surely all 4 of the license objectives; the protection of crime and disorder, the prevention of public nuisance, public safety and the protection of children from harm, would be undermined.

The town centre wards are oversubscribed with off licenses and residents are fully aware of the anti-social behaviour that is associated.
