LICENSING ACT 2003: APPLICATION TO VARY PREMISES LICENCE – CASSIDY’S, 41-45 GRANGE ROAD, MIDDLESBROUGH – REF: MBRO/PROO18/17998

A report of the Head of Community Protection had been circulated outlining an application to vary the Premises Licence for Cassidy’s, 41-45 Grange Road, Middlesbrough, Ref: MBRO/PROO18/17998.

The Principal Licensing Officer advised that prior to the meeting a letter dated 18 July 2005 had been received from Mincoffs Solicitors, representing the applicant, requesting that the application for Variation of the Premises Licence be withdrawn.

Accordingly, the Sub-Committee was informed that the application to vary had been withdrawn and the matter would be dealt with as a Conversion only. No representations had been received from Cleveland Police in relation to the conversion application.

LICENCE CONVERSION GRANTED

ORDERED:

That in the absence of representations from the Police, the application under the Licensing Act 2003 to convert the existing Licence for Cassidy’s, 41-45 Grange Road, Middlesbrough would be automatically granted after 28 days, to become effective from the second appointed date of 24 November 2005.
