1. Notification to Police:

A copy of the Temporary Event Notice was faxed to Cleveland Police by the Licensing Section on 20 September 2006.

2. Legislation

Section 8.16 of the Government Guidance in relation to The Licensing Act 2003 makes it clear that when considering a Temporary Event Notice, the Licensing Authority is confined in the hearing, to consideration of the crime prevention objective and that it cannot uphold an objection notice on other grounds, such as public nuisance.

3. Background

The premises consists of a Night Club in Middlesbrough town centre trading with the benefit of a Premises Licence. A copy of the current Premises Licence summary is reproduced at Appendix 2 of this report.
