4. Background

The premises consist of a convenience store situated within a parade of retail units on Trimdon Avenue, Middlesbrough. There are residential properties in close proximity to the premises. A location plan is attached at Appendix 2.

5. The Representations

On 13 February 2013 a representation was received from Mr G W Rogers, a local resident, objecting to the application on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder and the protection of children from harm. A copy of this representation is attached at Appendix 3.

On 1 March 2013 a representation was received from Mrs N White, a local resident, objecting to the application on the grounds of the prevention of public nuisance. A copy of this representation is attached at Appendix 4.

On 4 March 2013 a petition containing over 350 signatories was received. Petitioners object to the application on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm. A copy of this petition is attached at Appendix 5.

On 5 March 2013 a representation was received from Cleveland Police objecting to the application on the grounds of the prevention of crime and disorder, the prevention of public nuisance, public safety and the protection of children from harm.  The premises are a brick built construction and presently trade as a convenience store but without the benefit of a Premises Licence. Included with this application is a layout plan which confirms that the whole of the retail sales floor area is proposed to be covered by this application. Alcohol will be displayed within the retail area in such positions where it can be supervised by a combination of direct staff supervision and/or CCTV. The CCTV system will form part of the due diligence system which will be operable at the store (images will be maintained for a minimum of 31 days) The due diligence systems will also incorporate the operation of a refusals record together with general staff training providing guidance upon both the legal and social aspects of selling alcohol. The Company also provide continual external support through test purchasing operations. The Licensable activities will take place between the hours as specified on page 17 of this application form. These premises will benefit from a Premises Licence for consumption of alcohol off the premises only. there will be no adult entertainment in order to ensure compliance with legislation. The company will operate a 'Challenge 25' policy as a minimum requirement whereby any person appearing to be aged 25 or under must prove that they are in fact over the lawful age of 18 for the purpose of sale of alcohol. Acceptable forms of identification as proof of age are a ten year passport, a photocard driving licence and an approved PASS logo proof of age card. All staff are obligated to familiarise themselves with these requirements. The company will operate a due diligence policy, incorporating the minimum challenge 25 policy as above, also incorporating full training for all staff, the operation of a refusal record and refresher training on a regular basis.

This store will operate a fully recordable cctv system which is overtly operable. There will be a prominent signage located throughout the store confirming the legal minimum age for the purchase of alcohol and the company policy.

P Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)

We are a national retailer that sells alcohol as part of a broad offering of goods and services. We have held off-licenses in our stores for many years and are an approved British Institute of Inn-Keeping examination centre. We have written training policies and formal training programs are in place, which ensure our people are equipped to meet all licensing objectives. All training and revision / refresher materials are reviewed regularly. We have introduced our "Think 25" policy to all our stores, this policy is brought to the customers attention through point of sale material at the checkout and wherever alcohol is displayed for sale.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The premises has digital CCTV system that covers many areas of the shop floor, including the proposed area which will be used for display of beer and wine. High value alcoholic products such as champagne and spirits will be displayed behind the sales counter. Images are retained for a minimum of 31 days and made available on request by an authorised person. A member of the Management team is on the premises all the time the store is open.

c) Public safety

A member of the Management team is on the premises all the time the store is open and is trained to manage the store including looking after the safety of the public. The store adheres to all rules and regulations relating to public safety.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

These premises are proposed to be licensed for the consumption of liquor off the premises only. In addition to there being no consumption on the premises, there is no form of entertainment on the premises. There are no outdoor area utilised for the benefit of member of the public and the nature of the operation does not require the employment of door superisors or use of dedicated cab firms. The store is an active member of the community and is always happy to liaise with police and enforcement authorities should the need arise.

e) The protection of children from harm

All staff are trained and have regular refresher training on the corporate "Think 25" policy. Staff are trained to look at the customer and "Think 25" when selling age restricted products. A till prompt will appear on the initial sale of alcohol that will remind the seller of the Think 25 policy and remind staff not to sell alcohol to anyone under the age of 18. The Company also provide continual external support through test purchasing operations. When alcohol is refused by the seller the refusal is recorded and refusals frequently checked on a regular basis by a Manager. The store displays signage around the store informing both staff and customers of our "Think 25" policy.



The problem of antisocial behaviour around the shops could increase. This would cause a nuisance to local residents. It may also deter customers from using other local businesses if there was an increase in antisocial behaviour. The majority of shops along the parade are run by independent traders. A drop in custom due to these issues arising would be detrimental to both the business owners and the customers they serve.

Noise levels would increase if the shop were allowed to open for longer hours. The car park is situated directly opposite residential housing & residential housing is situated above the shopping parade. Customers using vehicles to visit the shops would create noise outside the hours the shops are currently open. The shop also has security shutters which would disturb residents late at night.

There are already 2 licenced premises along this short stretch of Trindon Avenue. Spar & The Grenadier.

Policing cover would be stretched due to incidents requiring police attendance.

A large number of children use the premises at present, it is marketed as a newsagents. These children would be exposed to the sale of alcohol. They may attempt to purchase alcohol or ask adults to purchase it for them. This would cause a nuisance to customers visiting the shops, and increase the probability of young people being able to access under age alcohol consumption.

We would like to be informed of the policy Martins intend to adopt to prevent these issues arising.

Staff could be subjected to threatening or abusive behaviour. The shop is staffed by one member of staff for most of the day. The store layout does not allow staff to have good vision of the premises to observe customers selecting alcohol. This could have a detrimental effect on staff safety.

The shopping parade is a designated alcohol free zone. Would there be additional resources to police this? Another off licence would increase the likelihood of the zone being abused.

There are many off licences in the nearby postcodes already, namely:

Tesco, Blue Bell

Tesco, Acklam Road

Co-op Brookfield

Wine shop Virginia Gardens

Spar Acklam Road

Booze Busters, Acklam Road

Spar, Trindon Avenue

Litter problems would increase, leading to a detrimental affect on the local enviroment and extra costs to the council to keep the area tidy. There is a park at the rear of the shops, which could be used by youths drinking. Broken glass, discarded cans etc. would create a safety issue to the young children who use the facility.
