Cleveland Police make application to review this premises licence for the following reasons:

At 2024 hours on Wednesday 21st January 2015 we attended MIDI'S MINI MARKET, 199 BOROUGH ROAD, MIDDLESBROUGH. At this time two Test Purchase volunteers who were aged 15 years entered the store to purchase alcohol as part of an operation. The two volunteers walked up to a fridge unit which contained various brands of alcohol and selected 4x cans of Stella Artois lager. The volunteers had paid £5.49p for the cans and they had not been challenged regarding the sale, or asked for any form of identification.

I then entered the store with PC CRAIG in order to speak to the male shop assistant. The male assistant identified himself as [REDACTED] and stated that his daughter owned the premises however he works there on a regular basis. I pointed out to him that he had just sold 4x cans of lager to two underage females; at this I placed the carrier bag on to the counter. [REDACTED] stated that he hadn't realised they were underage and then went on to say that he needed an interpreter. Due to this I no longer pushed the issue and obtained some more details from him in order to get in touch with him at a later date.

On Thursday 22nd January 2015 I contacted the telephone number that [REDACTED] had provided me with however this number was not recognised. I then looked for an address for him and this appeared to be an address in the Darlington area, the telephone number he provided was a Middlesbrough telephone number.

I am a Police Constable with Cleveland Police. I am currently stationed at MIDDLESBROUGH POLICE STATION (M8), BRIDGE STREET WEST attached to the District Licensing Unit (DLU).

At 2020 hours on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2015 I was on duty in plain clothes in company with PC1237 CRAIG. We were carrying out a Test Purchase Operation in relation to underage sales at off licences. This operation consists of sending two underage volunteers in to the store to purchase alcohol.

At 2024 hours on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2015 we attended MIDI'S MINI MARKET, 199 BOROUGH ROAD, MIDDLESBROUGH. At this time two Test Purchase volunteers who were aged 15 years entered the store to purchase alcohol as part of the operation. I was standing outside of the store however I could see the volunteers through the glass window. The two volunteers walked up to a fridge unit which contained various brands of alcohol and selected 4x cans of Stella Artois lager. The volunteers then approached the till area and placed the cans on to the counter. I could see a male behind the counter who I would

describe as elderly, and of Asian appearance. The male then placed the Stella Artois in to a white carrier bag before being handed money by the volunteers.

The volunteers then left the store and handed me the white carrier bag containing the alcohol. I placed the alcohol in to a police evidence bag and sealed it. I exhibit the alcohol as JKB/1. Bag reference number P03405513. The volunteers told me that they had paid £5.49p for the cans and that they had not been challenged regarding the sale, or asked for any form of identification.

I then entered the store with PC CRAIG in order to speak to the male shop assistant. The male assistant identified himself as [REDACTED] and stated that his daughter owned the premises however he works there on a regular basis. I pointed out to him that he had just sold 4x cans of lager to two underage females; at this I placed the carrier bag on to the counter. [REDACTED] stated that he hadn't realised they were underage and then went on to say that he needed an interpreter. Due to this I no longer pushed the issue and obtained some more details from him in order to get in touch with him at a later date.

On Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> January 2015 I once again attended the store in order to obtain the CCTV footage from the underage sale. Upon entering the store I spoke with a male behind the counter who identified himself as [REDACTED] and stated that he was a member of staff at the premises. I informed him that I had come to view CCTV footage of an underage sale that had occurred at the premise. He told me that the CCTV system had been replaced the day before and that he didn't know how to work it. I then went in to the office area with [REDACTED] to look at the system. It appeared to be a new system and the old hard drive was not present. He told me that the old hard drive had been disposed of and he didn't know how to operate the new system. He also stated that the people who run the shop were away in London and he was just looking after the place. Because of the obstructive manner of [REDACTED] PC CRAIG and I left the premises. [REDACTED] was not present on the premises at this time.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> February 2015 PC0532 TAYLOR who is the neighbourhood ward manager for the area surrounding the store, has provided a witness statement highlighting the issues at the location with Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) and underage drinking.

On the 5<sup>th</sup> March 2014 Cleveland Police received an application to transfer the premises licence in to the name of [REDACTED], at this time the Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) was [REDACTED] Cleveland Police then received a further request on the 18<sup>th</sup> March 2015 to make a variation to the licence in relation to the DPS. The licence was varied to allow [REDACTED] to be the DPS for the premises.

On the 21<sup>st</sup> August 2015 Cleveland Police received another application to vary the DPS at the premises to a [REDACTED]. The application stated that the previous DPS at the premise was a [REDACTED] however according to the records that the local authority and the police hold, the DPS was [REDACTED]. It is unclear at this time who is in day to day control of the premises and who is accountable for the previous incidents and underage sale at the shop. Each time police have paid a visit to the shop there has been a different member of staff behind the counter stating that they are just minding the shop for the manager.

At 1205 hours on Tuesday 20th October 2015 I paid a visit to the store in order to carry out a licensing check. I spoke with a male behind the counter who identified himself as [REDACTED] who stated that he was the licence holder and the DPS at the premise. I explained to him that I was carrying out a licensing check, and I identified several breaches of the licence conditions during the visit:

- No training records were present for staff members
- Unable to access the CCTV system to demonstrate 31 days of recording
- Two brands of "perry" products were on sale at the premise
- Refusals book has not had any entries since February 2014
- The incident book has not had any entries since May 2014 however there have been incidents reported to police since this time

From the 14<sup>th</sup> June 2014 – 13<sup>th</sup> June 2015 there have been 22 incidents of Anti Social Behaviour and general nuisance which I exhibit as JKB/2. There have been 13 alcohol related incidents in the vicinity of the store. I exhibit these incidents as JKB/3. The majority of the incidents have occurred at the North Ormesby flyover and the adjacent residential area which is a short walk from the premise.

The staff at the premise have been evasive and somewhat obstructive in relation to the CCTV footage of the underage sale. It is unclear at this time who is responsible for the running of the shop as staff on the premises are obstructive, or they say they are just "minding the place" for the owner. There are also several breaches of the current licensing conditions that have recently been identified.

Due to the underage sale at the premise and also the evidence of ASB and alcohol related incidents in the area, Cleveland Police believe a review of the premises licence is necessary as the protection of children from harm, and the prevention of crime and disorder objectives are undermined.

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:

(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

### Age Verification

3. The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

4. The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

5. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either:

(a) a holographic mark, or

(b) an ultraviolet feature.

### Permitted Price

6. A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

7. For the purpose of this condition set out in paragraph 1:

(a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;

(b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula-

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

Where:

(i) P is the permitted price,

(ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and

(iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;

(d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;

(e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of disability).

12. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

#### **Alcoholic Drink Measures**

13. The responsible person must ensure that:

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—

(i) beer or cider: ½ pint;

(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and

(iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;

(b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and

(c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.\*

*Good Afternoon Everyone*

*I am aware that this time a year especially with Bonfire Night looming that there is often an increase in reports of anti-social behaviour but can I please take this opportunity to make you aware of a raising community issue amongst residents of the Central Ward.*

*Recently the community have made several reports regarding the large amount of young people congregating in Saltwells Park and along Saltwells, Brimewells and Breckon Hill Road*

*These large groups of young people are reported to be making residents feel intimidated to the extent many will not leave their home after 3pm*

*Recently an elderly couple in Brimewells Green had young people throwing fireworks at the house and car and when the resident asked them to leave them alone a firework was thrown into the passageway which whizzed upstairs causing damage. This was reported to the Police and the couple have had problems in the past, but it seems they are being targeted.*

*I am aware that everyone is very stretched under budget constraints but I was wondering if anyone would be in a position to support my-self and a youth worker in a voluntary capacity to try and engage with the young people maybe during an evenings outreach, or if anyone has resources we could pull together and use for a couple of weeks, or could we put pressure on the enforcement agencies to address this.*

*In all my 11 years of working at Breckon Hill I have never heard residents report that they feel scared to walk the streets and that the groups of young people are causing so many problems.*

*I watched a large group on Monday evening chanting at a young lad in the park and when a guy walking his dog intercepted he was given verbal abuse and was chased out of the park, this was at half four in the evening when the park is normally used by children and families.*

*I am happy to meet with anyone or to facilitate meetings, consultation or anything that may help to resolve these issues*

*I look forward to hearing from you soon*

I am a Police Officer and I currently serve Cleveland police at Middlesbrough police station.

I am currently the Neighbourhood ward Manager for the university ward of Middlesbrough.

My duties include tackling Anti social behaviour which on a number of occasions can be Alcohol fuelled and involves large groups of youths gathering in locations within the ward.

I also attend community meetings and hold beat surgeries in which I listen to the communities concerns and assist in tackling their concerns. Some of these concerns involve underage drinking and the issues this causes, involving criminal damage shouting and swearing and causing a nuisance.

On Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> of January 2015 whilst on patrol within the Ely street and saltwells Road areas of Middlesbrough I sighted 1 female and 2 males carrying a white plastic bag containing 3 bottles of cider. They were walking from the direction of the Northormesby footbridge where an off license by the name of MIDDIS is located on Borough road leading to the bridge. I stopped the youths who produced to me 3 x 3 litre bottles of cider to which I seized as the 3 youths stated they were 16 years old. A short time later I was approached by a member of the public who stated that MIDDIS always sold alcohol to underage

persons and that they had served the youths I had spoken to. I was also aware that MIDDIS used white carrier bags.

Saltwells Road and Ely Street at the time was a ward priority due to youths drinking alcohol and causing criminal damage gathering under the Northormesby flyover only a few hundred yards from MIDDIS off license. I have dealt with numerous youths from around November 2014 who gather and drink alcohol. These youths disperse into the estate on one such occasion I sighted a number of youths within MIDDIS who on seeing myself walked out I believe that these youths were confident in the fact they may be sold alcohol.

Between 22<sup>nd</sup> of October 2014 and 19<sup>th</sup> of November numerous calls were made from residents of Ely street who contacted police on 11 occasion's who were suffering anti social behaviour at the hands of groups of youths gathering under the flyover . Some of these incidents involved assault and criminal damage to property. One of the residents approached me who was visibly upset and distressed pointing towards the flyover in the direction of MIDDIS stating that was were they bought their alcohol from.

This particular area requires police patrols as it does become an area for youths to gather .
