 - details of the time and date the refusal was made;
 - the identity of the staff member refusing the sale;
 - details of the alcohol the person attempted to purchase.

This book/register will be available for inspection by a police officer or other authorised officer on request

- 2. An incident book/register shall be maintained to record:
 - All incidents of crime and disorder occurring at the premises.
 - Details of occasions when the police are called to the premises.

This book/register will be available for inspection by a police officer or other authorised officer on request.

- 3. All sales tills shall prompt the cashier making a sale of alcohol to verify that the customer is aged 18 or over.
- 4. There shall be no sale of single cans of beer, lager or cider from the premises.
- 5. There shall be no sale of single bottles of beer, lager or cider in vessels of less than 500ml or more than 1500ml.
- 6. There shall be no sale of perry based products from the premises save for products that have been agreed by the police (email approval will suffice).
- 7. There will be no sales/supplies of beers, ales, lagers or ciders of 6.0% ABV or above.
- 8. The licence holder will monitor the primary use of the premises and if transaction data demonstrates that the premises are excluded premises pursuant to s.176 of the Licensing Act 2003 the sale of alcohol will cease until such time as the data demonstrates that the premises are not so excluded. Such data will be available on request to the police and the licensing authority. This condition will fall away if s.176 is repealed.
