We write to object against the application made for the sale of alcohol 'off' the premises at 121 Victoria Road. These premises have applied for a license in the past, this was rejected for a reason, and therefore it should not be granted a license. There has been an increase of anti-social behavior in the area which relates to the sale of alcohol.
