17/13 MINUTES - LOCAL PLAN WORKING GROUP - 12 MARCH 2018

The minutes of the meeting of the Local Plan Working Group held on 12 March 2018 were taken as read and approved.

17/14 CHANGES TO THE NATIONAL PLANNING POLICY FRAMEWORK

The Government has published for consultation changes to the National Planning Policy Framework. AC summarised the main changes which include:

- A standardised methodology for assessing housing need to replace the existing approach in SHMAs.
- This approach does not take into account ambition.
- Local Plan to address housing needs of specific groups of people including students and older people.
- New Housing Delivery Test.
- Measure of delivery against need over 3 year period.
- Comes into effect November 2018.
- Viability Plans subject to viability assessment.
- Plans to set out policy requirements from development sites.
- Expectation is that viability should not be necessary at application stage (if development accords with the Plan) – concern about how realistic this approach is.
- Statements of common ground between Duty to cooperate bodies.
- Requirement for 20% of housing supply on small sites.
- Additional CIL/S106 consultation.

The closing date for the consultation is 10th May 2018, the Council is intending to submit a response to the consultation. The revised NPPF is likely to be published in the Summer.
