- 3.3 The Panel has therefore considered a wide range of suitable topics for inclusion into the Panel's Draft Work Programme. **Appendix 1** details the

Panel's suggested Draft Work Programme in order of priority to be considered by the Overview and Scrutiny Board.

- 3.4 In addition to the above, the Panel have also acknowledged that throughout the 2004/05 Municipal Year it may be necessary to respond on an ad hoc basis to emerging issues which would be considered appropriate for a review to be undertaken.
