# PROGRESS REPORT

### PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To provide Members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board with an update on the progress of the Economic Regeneration and Transport Scrutiny Panel.

#### PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

- 3. The review of the preparation of the Local Transport Plan is well underway. The panel met on 7 September to receive evidence from officers from Economic Regeneration and Environment on issues including congestion in Middlesbrough, developing transport policies to encourage economic regeneration and encouraging alternative forms of transport.
- 4. As part of the review the Panel also undertook a visit to the Council's Traffic Control Centre to view how the Council manage the flow of traffic in Middlesbrough.
- 5. The panel is planning to finalise the review in November with the final panel meeting scheduled for 25 November.
- 6. The date of the Mayor's final transport debate has been altered, so I will be attending the rescheduled debate on 21 October.
