COMMUNITY SAFETY and LEISURE SCRUTINY PANEL PROGRESS REPORT

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

- 1 To inform Members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board of the progress made to date by the Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel.

RECOMMENDATION

- 2 It is recommended that the Overview and Scrutiny Board approves the actions of the Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel resulting from its meetings of November 2004.

PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

3. The Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel were scheduled to meet on the 30th November. At which time the Panel would discuss the actions of the Panel and the information received from various sources which would form the basis of the Panels Final Report. Emphasis was to be placed on the information received from the Executive member who had met the partners forming the Active Middlesbrough Strategy Forum.
- 4 In practice the meeting scheduled for the 30th November was inquorate and therefore members present discussed informally the information

received to date. Members also scheduled future meetings for the panel at three week intervals for the remainder of the municipal year.

- 5 The Panels next meeting is scheduled for the 21st December. This meeting is targeted to consider the draft report. The Panel considers that it has received sufficient information to formulate a judgement on the direction and achievements of the Active Middlesbrough Strategy and once agreed will be presented to the Overview and Scrutiny Board for consideration.
- 6 Members also discussed the next subject to be addressed and while the programme indicates that Access to Drug treatment would be the next subject the Panel intends to address this and other issues at their meeting scheduled for 21st December.
