- 4. Since my last progress report to this Board on 16 November 2004, the Panel has considered the Final Report into our first investigation into the Authority's Allotment service provision.
- 5. The Final Report details nine key recommendations, which are to be considered by the Overview and Scrutiny Board at a later stage during this meeting and the Executive thereafter.
- 6. I am also pleased to inform this Board that this scrutiny investigation has certainly attracted the attention of the local media, with live radio interviews, newspaper articles together with television coverage.
- 7. As per the agreed Work Programme of this Panel, our next investigation is to review the Green Budget in the context of the Housing Stock Transfer.

- 8. Recently, the Scrutiny Officer and I met with key officers to discuss the proposed remit of this investigation, which is to be further considered by the Panel at its meeting on 15 December 2004.
- 9. It is envisaged that this Scrutiny investigation will conclude by the end of this current 2004/05 Municipal Year.
