OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY BOARD 11 JANUARY 2005

OUTCOME OF CALL-IN: PROVISION OF A BMX TRACK IN THE BEECHWOOD WARD

PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To report the outcome of the Special Meeting of Overview and Scrutiny Board (OSB) held on 5 January 2005 to review the key decision made by an Individual Executive Member on 17 December 2004, in accordance with the Authority's Call-In Procedure.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2. As Members will recall, the Call-In Procedure was recently instigated, following a decision undertaken by the Executive Member for Community Safety and Leisure. The decision was to support a bid to provide a BMX track adjacent to the Community Centre in the Beechwood Ward, subject to management arrangements being secured (Individual Executive Decision-Making Meeting held on 17 December 2004 refers).
- 3. Subsequently a Special Meeting of the OSB was held on 5 January 2005 to allow the Board to review the decision taken.

OBSERVATIONS

4. Having reviewed the decision, the Board would like to make the following observations on this issue:-

- (a) The consultation process was weak and focussed almost entirely on the 'mud hills'. Little evidence was presented which indicated any widespread consultation had been undertaken on the new proposal;
- (b) The consultation process undertaken in 2003 clearly took place against a background of sharply divergent views, both between the Elected Wards Members and between residents; and
- (c) As a result of this (point (b) refers), the Council should have undertaken more independent consultation of residents' views (specifically regarding the proposal) rather than relying principally on the Community Council.

CONCLUSION

5. The OSB concluded that on this occasion the Board would not be recommending the Executive Member for Community Safety and Leisure to formally re-consider the decision.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 6. The Board's key recommendations to the Executive Member for Community Safety and Leisure are as outlined below:-
 - (a) That the observations outlined in paragraph 4 are noted;
 - (b) That should the bid be approved, that detailed consultation on the design proposal be undertaken; and
 - (c) That in the event of the bid being accepted and the project going ahead, the Council should identify a specific budget for security, CCTV, lighting, management arrangements and maintenance of the site.
