PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

In terms of the evidence gathering at the Panel's meeting on 9 February, Members received evidence from the service area regarding the operation of the Validation Panel. The panel, made up of senior officers from social services, meets to ensure that there is consistency in its assessments of service users. A small number of members from the scrutiny panel are to attend a Validation Panel meeting on 9 March to view its operation for themselves and report their findings back to the panel.
- 4. For the final evidence gathering session members of the panel are going to meet with service users and carers at the Lansdowne Centre in order to hear their views on the impact of the change in the FACS policy.
