PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

The Panel met representatives from four Community Councils, to ensure the Panel has a realistic understanding of how these organisations operated.

- 5. Representatives of the Community Councils outlined the level of attendance at their meetings and indicated the relationship with Ward Members. This was followed by a discussion of the range of issues that faced Community Councils and were considered at their meetings.
- 6. The Chair of the Panel has distributed a questionnaire for all members to complete. The results of which are targeted to be conveyed to the Panel's next meeting, scheduled for 21st April 2005.
