COMMUNITY SAFETY and LEISURE SCRUTINY PANEL PROGRESS REPORT

PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

3. The Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel held a meeting on the 5th April 2005 when it engaged with Cleveland Police Superintendent of Operations. The Superintendent outlined the benefits derived from utilising the AIM process in tackling crime and areas of achievement to date. It was also conveyed to the panel the level of engagement and cohesion from the Police perspective with members of the Partnership who attend the weekly AIM meetings. The Superintendent informed the Panel this has demonstrated positive

- benefits in the mobilisation of resources to combat crime in Middlesbrough.
