During this meeting the Panel visited the Warden Control Centre where it undertook enquiries into the deployment of Wardens on a daily basis. The Panel also visited the Intelligence room where the latest details and information is collated to ensure Wardens have the latest intelligence.

5. The Panel is scheduled to meet again on the 16th August when it is intending to engage with the Executive Member for Community Safety and leisure. The Panel will also be analysing the information derived from the meeting at the Warden Control Centre held on 26th July.
