PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To receive the decision of the Executive on the Overview and Scrutiny Board's final report on Emergency Admissions at James Cook University Hospital.

BACKGROUND

2. The Board will be aware that as part of the scrutiny processes, the Executive at its meeting on 20 December 2005, considered the findings of the Health Scrutiny Panel's Final Report on Emergency Admissions at James Cook University Hospital. This report represents the formal notification to this Board of the Executive's decisions in respect of the report.
3. In that regard, in addition to the Board's report, the Executive also considered both the Service Response (appendix 1) together with the response of the Corporate Management Team (CMT).
