#### PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

5. The Panel has therefore considered a wide range of suitable topics for inclusion into the Panel's Draft Work Programme. Appendix 1 details the Panel's suggested Draft Work Programme in order of priority to be considered by the Overview and Scrutiny Board.
6. In addition to the above, the Panel have also acknowledged that throughout the 2006/07 Municipal Year it may be necessary to respond on an ad hoc basis to

emerging issues which would be considered appropriate for a review to be undertaken.
