PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1. To provide members of the Overview and Scrutiny Board (OSB) with an update on the work of the Scrutiny Panel.

BACKGROUND

- 2. The Environment Scrutiny Panel is continuing its scrutiny investigation of waste services. At the panel's last meeting (12 October 2007), information was submitted as follows:
 - Officers from Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council attended the meeting to explain how recycling rates in that borough had been increased from 12% to 36% over the last three years.
 - A summary was submitted in respect of the findings of a Parliamentary Select Committee on refuse collection (the full document having also been made available to panel members).
 - A report was submitted on Council trade waste activities.
- 3. The panel's findings will be included in its final report on this topic, which will be submitted to OSB in due course.
