CHIEF EXECUTIVE

PURPOSE OF REPORT

To receive the decisions of the Executive on Scrutiny Panel final reports on Speed Cameras and the Erimus Housing Grounds Maintenance Contract.

BACKGROUND

1. The Board will be aware that as part of the scrutiny processes, the Executive at its meeting on the 24 June 2008, considered the findings of the Community Safety and Leisure Scrutiny Panel's final report on its investigation into Speed Cameras and the Environment Scrutiny Panel's final report on the Erimus Housing, Grounds Maintenance Contract.
2. This report represents the formal notification to the Board of the Executive's decisions in respect of the two reports.
3. In addition to the reports, the Executive also considered the Service Responses (Appendices A & B respectively) which had also been considered by Corporate Management Team (CMT). CMT had agreed to support the Service Responses to the Final Reports.
