PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

BACKGROUND

- 2. Since the last update to the Board the panel have concluded their review of Community Centres.
- 3. At the panel's next meeting on 15 December, Members will be considering a briefing paper prepared by the Director of Regeneration. The briefing sets out the history of the population change in Middlesbrough and considers at the key factors which have influenced changes in population numbers and the actions that are being taken by the Regeneration Service to reverse population decline.
- 4. The report has been prepared in order to assist the panel in a short scoping exercise to enable Members to review the issues and to determine if they wish to pursue a full review of the topic. The outcome of that meeting will be reported verbally to the Board.
