The article in the Evening Gazette on the 12th March 2009 states that at least 300+carers used the centre each week. Carers should be given the choice of visiting the centre in Middlesbrough or outreach services into the carers home. Some carers would prefer to visit a centre as they spend a lot of time in their properties looking after their disabled families and friends and it gives the carers a break."

- 5. The suggested Scrutiny topic should be considered against the following criteria:-
  - (i) Does the issue affect a group of people living within the Middlesbrough area;
  - (ii) Relate to a service, event or issue in which the Council has a significant stake or over which the Council has an influence:
