SCRUTINY REVIEW – IMPLEMENTATION OF RECOMMENDATIONS

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To inform the Board of the progress achieved with the implementation of agreed Executive actions resulting from the consideration of scrutiny reports.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

- 2. At the Overview and Scrutiny Board meeting, which was held on 28 July 2009, a request was made by the Board that a further report be submitted to today's meeting in respect of the 14 partially completed and 9 Executive actions which had not been implemented by the target date.
- 3. Officers, responsible for outstanding actions, were asked to provide information detailing the reason/s for the delayed implementation.
- 4. Provided within Appendix A is an update, on the outstanding actions, in respect of following reports: -
 - Investigation into the Development and Enhancement of Community Engagement in Middlesbrough
 - Residents' Parking Scheme
 - Middlesbrough Council's Waste Services
 - Teenagers Hanging Around
 - Public Transport in Middlesbrough
 - Speed Cameras
 - Erimus Housing Grounds Maintenance Contract
 - Major Adaptations
 - Extended Schools
 - Aspects of the Council's Corporate Parenting Responsibilities
 - Improving Levels of Employment for People with Disabilities
 - Review of Community Centres
 - Middlesbrough Youth Service and Connexions

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- 4. The update as of **28 July 2009** explained that of the **546** Executive actions which should have been implemented by June 2009: -
 - 523 had been implemented;
 - 14 were partially complete;
 - 9 had not been implemented.
- 5. Following the request for additional information, the revised position is as follows:
 - 530 had been implemented;
 - **13** were partially complete;
 - 3 had not been implemented.

RECOMMENDATION

6. That the Board considers the information presented in Appendix A and agrees an appropriate course of action to monitor the recommendations that have not been implemented by the proposed target date.
