PROPOSED SCRUTINY TOPIC

- 3. To consider undertaking an investigation into **Pest Control Services**.
- 4. The reasons for this request are as follows:

"There is a need to identify how rat infestation is dealt with and who is responsible for the baiting of sewers (with a focus on external agencies in particular Northumbrian Water). Rat infestation is a growing problem and something the Council should take a lead on thus ensuring an efficient and effective service. There is a need to ascertain if there is a growth in the problem of the rat population, who is ultimately responsible and are we increasing or decreasing the specifications to deal with the problem."

- 5. The suggested Scrutiny topic should be considered against the following criteria:-
- (i) Does the issue affect a group of people living within the Middlesbrough area;
- (ii) Relate to a service, event or issue in which the Council has a significant stake or over which the Council has an influence;

- (iii) Not be an issue which Overview & Scrutiny has considered during the last 12 months;
- (iv) Not relate to an individual service complaint; and
- (v) Not relate to matters dealt with by another Council committee, unless the issue deals with procedure.
- 6. It is for the Board to consider the importance of this suggestion in light of the work programme.
