PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

- 3 Community Courts. The Panel was scheduled to meet on the 24th September. However, unfortunately due to unforeseen circumstances this meeting had to be cancelled this meeting and re scheduled for the 14th October. As the OSB report is distributed before this meeting is held. I will update the Board verbally on the progress and issues derived from the meeting on the 14th October when representatives of the Community Court will be in attendance.
- The panel has also arranged to visit the Community Justice Court in Liverpool regarding the use of this court as a means of comparison with Middlesbrough

and as a measure of good practice. However, one of the key aspects is the way the Court operates as a review of Community Orders. This visit to Liverpool is scheduled to take place on the 2nd November and again I will reference this at the board meeting.

Future Meetings. Due to the cancellation of the 24th September meeting, this has required the rescheduling of subsequent meetings, and now Road Safety has been rescheduled to the November panel meeting when it will also be receiving detail on Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act (RIPA).
