FEEDBACK FROM EXECUTIVE – 2 February 2010

CHIEF EXECUTIVE

PURPOSE OF REPORT

1. To receive the decisions of the Executive on the Overview and Scrutiny Board's final report on Stroke Services.

BACKGROUND

2. The Board will be aware that as part of the scrutiny processes, the Executive at its meeting on 2 February 2010 considered the findings of the Health Scrutiny Panel's final report on Stroke Services.

This report represents the formal notification to the Board of the Executive's decisions in respect of the reports.

3. In addition to the reports, the Executive also considered the Service Response in relation to the Health Scrutiny Panel's final report on Stroke Services. (Appendix A) which had also been considered by Corporate Management Team (CMT). CMT agreed to support the Service Response and note the response from Middlesbrough PCT.
4. Councillor E Dryden, Chair of the Health Scrutiny Panel presented the final report to the Executive.
5. In considering the item, the Executive supported the Service Response and noted the response from Middlesbrough PCT subject to one amendment.

The Executive could not support recommendation C as the Council should not be requesting Community Councils to spend their budgets on Council Initiatives. The service response was therefore amended to request Community Councils to promote Stroke awareness through means (e.g. newsletters) that would not require the use of Community Council budgets.
