# COMMUNITY SAFETY and LEISURE SCRUTINY PANEL PROGRESS REPORT

#### PROGRESS OF THE PANEL

- 3 **Community Courts.** The Board will be aware that this item was deferred at its meeting of 6<sup>th</sup> April and is scheduled to be considered at this meeting
- 4 **Crime and Disorder Reduction Partnership** (Safer Middlesbrough Partnership) The panel met the SMP in April and from those enquiries the panel has asked for some specific detail regarding one of the strategic priorities referenced by the SMP. This priority is "Delivering young people away from crime and ASB" The panel has requested that this information be

presented to the Panel in June/July 2010 and the SMP have been notified accordingly.

Designated Public Place Order (DPPO). The panel had an initial setting the scene meeting with the Public Protection service in March regarding DPPO. At their last meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> April the panel agreed their terms of reference and lines of enquiry. At this meeting the panel also took evidence from the Police regarding how they undertake DPPO's, how evidence is collated and how they see the future for DPPO's. The panel has determined who they want to invite to their next meeting, which will be after the annual meeting.
